Hannah's Testimony

I grew up in a very loving family with all the opportunities in the world. My parents took great care of me and my siblings and I never knew any real trauma. Nor did I have any real knowledge of God or Jesus Christ other than my grandma telling me that the man upstairs is watching me and loves me. It all sounded like a fantasy to me. When I hit 19 I was introduced to a man who brought me to my knees with fear, in the worst way. I began drinking and using drugs to cover my pain.

I kept trying in my own strength to bring myself out of addiction. I could not. After 15 years of addiction, the separation of my family and I became permanent. My parents took my two girls at 8 and one year of age and told me I could not come in their house. It took me to living on the streets of St. Louis for the next two years. Right at the end of that two years I ended up staying with a man I did not know in an abandoned house with no food and no money. After a desperate call to a friend and an even more desperate prayer to God, "God, if you're real, take my life. I can't do this anymore."

God moved so intensely and so quickly it takes my breath away now. God sent my friend on a mission to contact me and locate me downtown. By the next 24 hours God had me here at Diane's House Adult & Teen Challenge of St. Louis.

Never could I have imagined my prayer to be answered the way He did or even at all. I gave my life to Jesus on my knees the night I arrived here, and it's been so beautiful the work He has done in and through me. My family is being restored, I have seen my girls, and I have hope
